

Visiting AllianzGI in Munich

The AllianzGI office is located close to the center of Munich. The address is:

Seidlstr. 24 – 24a
80335 Munich

The building is open 24 hours. When you arrive, please check in at reception, where you will receive a badge. If you have luggage, you can leave it in the cloakroom.

The closest U-Bahn (subway) stations are **Stiglmaierplatz (U1)** and **Königsplatz (U2)**.

How to get to the AllianzGI office

Using Public Transport – “The Green Option”

Munich has a reliable, safe and easy-to-use public transportation system, with which you can travel from Munich airport or Munich Central Station to the AllianzGI office. You can buy your ticket from a vending machine at the station where you start your journey. Before you commence your journey, validate your ticket with a date stamp by inserting it into one of the small, blue machines by the entrance of the station. Remember to keep your ticket handy throughout your journey, as inspectors carry out frequent spot checks. Please note, you will need cash to buy tickets for public transport; the machines do not take credit cards.

To get to the AllianzGI Munich offices from **Munich Airport**, take the S1 or S8 “S-Bahn” (local trains, leave approximately every 10 minutes) from the airport to Munich Central Station (Hauptbahnhof). The journey takes 40 – 45 minutes.

From **Munich Central Station** you can take the U1 or the U2 U-Bahn lines. Take the U1 going to **Olympia Einkaufszentrum** or **Westfriedhof** and get off at **Stiglmaierplatz**, one stop after Munich Central Station. Take the exit labelled “Brienner Str./ Dachauer Str”. This takes you on to Seidlstraße. Walk down Seidlstraße, crossing Dachauer Straße and Karlstraße.



After approximately 300 meters, you will see the AllianzGI offices on your left.

Alternatively, take the U2 going to **Feldmoching** and get off at **Königsplatz**, one stop after Munich Central Station. Take the exit marked “Karl-/Luisenstraße”. This brings you on to Karlstraße. Continue along Karlstraße, walk past the Tengelmann supermarket on your right and cross Augustenstraße and Dachauerstraße. You will then come to Seidlstraße. Turn left and you will see the AllianzGI offices on your left.

By Taxi

Taxis in Munich are pale yellow. They are easy to order, reliable and efficient. The prices are regulated and each taxi has a visible meter. A taxi from the airport to the Munich offices, or to any destination in the town center will cost approximately 60–80 EUR, depending on traffic. Not all taxis take credit cards. Please check with the driver. If you pre-order a taxi, make sure you specify credit card payment in advance. Please also refer to the guidelines on tipping on page 3.
